Committee Election Results: The results of the 2009 COC Election were as follows: for LAA 1 – Bob McClanahan, LAA 2 – Jewel Eibeck, LAA 3 – K. G. Cummins, LAA 4 – Jerry Martin. Their terms began January 1, 2010.

Committee Nominations Open: The 2010 election will be in Local Administrative Area 1 (LAA 1). The Service Center is accepting Nominations (FSA-669A) for LAA 1 now through August 2, 2010. Voting begins on November 5, and must be postmarked by December 6, 2010. The ballots will be counted at the Falmouth Service on December 9, 2010 at 9:00 A.M.

The boundary descriptions and voting dates of the Local Administrative Areas (LAA'S) are as follows:

LAA 1 – Northern Pendleton County: on the West along the Northern side of Hwy 22 to Hwy 27 and then South again to Hwy 22 on the East across the entire County. This is the LAA that will be having the COC election for 2010.


LAA 2 – Southern Pendleton County: on the West along the Northern side of Hwy 22 to Hwy 27 and then South again to Hwy 22 on the East across the entire County. The COC election for LAA 2 will be in 2012.

LAA 3 – Northern Grant County: On the West, northern side of Hwy 22 to Dry Ridge and then the northern side of Hwy 467 across to Pendleton County. The COC election for LAA 3 will be in 2011.

LAA 4 – Southern Grant County: On the West, Southern side of Hwy 22 to Dry Ridge and then the Southern side of Hwy 467 across to Pendleton County. The COC election for LAA 4 will be in 2012.

Nomination Forms: The nomination form (FSA-669A) is included in the newsletter as an insert. All nomination forms must be postmarked or returned to the Pendleton County FSA Office not later than **August 2, 2010**.
