
FSA has begun the process to elect county committees in our office for the next calendar year. The County Committees administer Federal Farm Programs at the local level and are responsible for establishing policy and the overall management of each FSA Office.

Persons nominated should be currently engaged in the operation of a farm and be well qualified for committee work. A farmer is eligible to be a County FSA Committee member if he or she lives in the LAA and is an eligible voter. County FSA Committee members may not hold positions in certain farm and commodity organizations if these positions pose a conflict of interest with FSA duties.

A nomination form signed by the nominee is needed to nominate a farmer-candidate. The form includes a statement that the candidate agrees to serve if elected. Blank nomination forms (FSA-669A's) may be obtained at our office or online at www.fsa.usda.gov.

LAA Boundaries: The county committee in Union County consists of three members, each member representing a Local Administrative Area (LAA) of the county. This year **LAA #1** will hold elections. This is the southeastern part of the county beginning at the Crittenden County line at Hwy 365 to Hwy 60 and following Hwy 60 northeast to the Henderson County line.
