Lynn Voigt is employed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Farm Service Agency (FSA), in Tualatin, Oregon, where he serves as the Agency's State Executive Director. In this capacity, Mr. Voigt is responsible for providing leadership in the delivery of the Agency's broad array of commodity and price support programs, conservation and habitat protection programs, direct and guaranteed loan programs, and disaster assistance programs through a network of 25 County Offices in Oregon.

Mr. Voigt grew up in Alvadore, Oregon, a small rural area northwest of Eugene. He graduated from Oregon State University in 1969 with a B.S. in Agricultural Economics, and began his career with the U.S. Department of Agriculture shortly before graduating. Mr. Voigt also earned a Masters degree in Applied Public Financial Management from American University in 1978 while working with the USDA in Washington, DC.
