



PUBLIC PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) encourages participation from all public stakeholders. This guidance is intended to answer questions about how the public may provide their comments for consideration by the Dairy Industry Advisory Committee (DIAC). This includes, but is not limited to, general members of the public, producers and producer organizations, processors and processor organizations, handlers, consumers, academia, retailers, and state agencies involved in organic and non-organic dairy at the local, regional, national, and international levels.

ATTENDING A MEETING OF THE DAIRY INDUSTRY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The time and location of the meeting and the public comment session will be published in the *Federal Register* at least 15 days before a meeting. Due to space limitations and security requirements, all attendees must register to attend the meeting before entering the meeting site. Information about how to register will be provided with the publication of the *Federal Register* notice for the meeting. The deadline for registration will be provided for each meeting. Please be prepared to provide a picture ID for entry to the meeting location and verification of registration.

PROVIDING PUBLIC COMMENT

The DIAC is interested in receiving comments identifying problems, but is most interested in receiving comments recommending solutions to problems. Comments received will be made available for public inspection and will be posted without change; we do not edit personal identifying information from submissions. You should submit only information that you wish to make available publicly.

To help us process and review your comments more efficiently, please use only one method.

Written submission of comments: Send paper comments in duplicate to Solomon Whitfield, Price Support Division, Farm Service Agency, USDA, 1400 Independence Avenue SW, Room 4095-S, Stop 0512, Washington, D.C. 20250-0512. Written comments can be submitted at any time.

Oral comments: Some of the DIAC meetings will include an open public comment session, during which interested persons may present relevant information or views orally. Date, time and details for registering to speak will be provided in the *Federal Register* notice for each meeting and posted to the website following publication of the notice. Time allotted for each presentation may be limited. If the number of registrants requesting to speak is greater than can be reasonably accommodated during the scheduled open public comment session, USDA may conduct a lottery to determine the speakers for the scheduled open public hearing session or provide reservations on a first come, first serve basis.
