

1 Revised FY 2009 Federal FLP Travel Allotments

A Background

DAFLP has authorized the transfer of \$177,900 from the ACIF Program Loan Cost Expense account to the FSA Salaries and Expenses account for FY 2009. Those funds will be issued to State Offices for travel associated with FLP activities.

B Purpose

This notice issues additional State Office Federal travel funds for FY 2009 FLP related travel needs.

D FLP Travel

See Exhibit 1 for revised Federal travel allotments. Exhibit 1 reflects current travel allotments as reflected in the Budget Status and Forecast Model as of June 2009, with adjustments for FLP travel.

The use of these funds should be prioritized in the State Office's FLP request for travel. Exhibit 1 does **not** reflect any other travel adjustments requested by States in July 2009.

These funds shall only be used statutorily for administrative travel cost associated with FLP. FLC's and AO's shall monitor and track the use of these travel funds.
