Section 1614 Reporting for Crop Year 2007

1 Overview

A Background

Section 1614 of the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 required that USDA establish procedures to track benefits provided, directly or indirectly, to individuals and entities under titles I and II for crop years 2002 through 2007.

FSA developed an internal process to capture program payment and benefit data applicable to each program participant, including those amounts attributed to members of joint operations and entities. See 1-CMA, paragraph 555 for instructions on providing crop year data for CMA's, DMA's and LSA's.

Because of farm Bill implementation and other resource issues, it has been determined that Section 1614 reporting from CMA's, DMA's and LSA's is on hold until further notice.

B Purpose

This notice advises CMA's LSA's, and DMA's that Section 1614 reports will **not** be submitted for crop year 2007.
