1 Acreage Reporting for CSA

A Background

Questions have been raised on how to report CSA on FSA-578.

B Purpose

This notice provides guidance for reporting crops supported by CSA.

C Crops Produced by CSA Reported on FSA-578

Producers must report all crops and land uses on FSA-578 to be eligible for program benefits. This includes crop acreage supported by CSA.

Producers who grow crops marketed through or for CSA or other similar marketing methods shall report the crop or crops they produce on FSA-578 based on their share in the crop. The acreage reported by the producer shall include all crops supported and managed by CSA.

All other reporting requirements must be met according to 2-CP.

Note: Program eligibility will be determined by the various program requirements.
