1 Overview

A Background

LFP compensates eligible livestock producers for grazing losses suffered because of drought conditions that occurred from January 1, 2008, to October 1, 2011.

Notice LDAP-15:

- provided a link for accessing a list of eligible LFP counties for calendar years 2008 and 2009
- explained how to determine the drought intensity level applicable for each specific pasture type.

To illustrate county eligibility for the three LFP payment tiers for eligible grazing types, maps are being created and posted on a designated Internet site.

These maps will identify eligibility at the county level and will assist Program Specialists and County Office employees in determining which counties are eligible.

B Purpose
