1 Web-Based DCIA Flag

A Background

The web-based eligibility system is designed to record information needed to ensure that only producers who comply with applicable program provisions receive USDA program benefits.

Notice PL-130 informed State and County Offices about the new web-based eligibility system nationwide deployment. 3-PL, paragraph 36 and Exhibit 6, subparagraph I, provide instructions for accessing and updating the DCIA flag in the web-based eligibility system.

State and County Offices shall continue to follow 58-FI, 1-FSFL, and 8-LP for marketing assistance loan (MAL), loan deficiency payment (LDP), and Farm Storage Facility Loan (FSFL) DCIA policy and procedures.

B Purpose

This notice instructs State and County Offices to ensure that the DCIA flag is appropriately set in the web-based eligibility system for producers requesting and/or already issued FSFL's, LDP's, and MAL's.

C Action

State and County Offices must ensure that the DCIA flag is appropriately set in the web-based eligibility system when it is determined or discovered that a producer is DCIA noncompliant.
