1 2011 Crop Peanut Warehouse Rates

A Background

The Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (2008 Act), Section 1307(a)(6)(A) authorizes the Secretary to use CCC funds to pay handling, and other associated costs (other than storage costs) to ensure proper storage of 2008 through 2012 crop year peanuts pledged as security for CCC MAL's. This handling amount will be added to the loan disbursement at loan making. The handling charges will include the State specific grading and inspection fees for peanuts.

Accordingly, Section 1307 (a)(6)(B)(i) of the 2008 Act requires the repayment of handling and associated cost when the MAL is redeemed.

For peanuts forfeited to CCC, the Secretary is authorized in Section 1307(a)(6)(b)(ii) to pay storage, handling and other associated costs for all peanuts pledged as collateral that are forfeited for the 2008 through 2012 crop years.

CCC will pay receiving charges and load-out charges if CCC deems it necessary to load-out CCC loan collateral on peanuts forfeited to CCC.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices of the:

- approved monthly storage rate, load-in and load-out charges
- receiving and load-out charges, when applicable, on peanuts forfeited to CCC.

2 Warehouse Charges

A Monthly Warehouse Charges

The monthly storage rates and receiving and load-out charges are on a per ton basis. The rates are provided in the following table.

Note: Rates include **\$30** plus the initial grading and inspection fee as determined by the State where the inspection was completed. Since the receiving rate in the table includes the cost for grading the peanuts, the cost of this service is the warehouse operator's responsibility and must be paid to AMS, Federal-State Inspection Service from the receiving fees.
