1 Price Support Payments Returned to Offsetable Status

A Background

Notice PS-657 informed State and County Offices that beginning October 5, 2009, APSS-generated disbursements, including FSFL and MILC payments were made nonoffsetable because of the heavy volume of CRP and DCP payments being processed at that time.

As a result, APSS corrections, receivable, and assignment processing from certain price support payments could not occur.

APSS-generated disbursements and MILC payments are now offsetable and APSS correction processing shall resume.

B Purpose

This notice informs States and County Offices that:

- the following disbursements have been returned to offsetable status:
 - MILC Payments
 - APSS-generated disbursements (including FSFL)
- correction activities for APSS-generated payments can resume.

C Reprocessing APSS-Generated Disbursement

If a receivable must be offset from an APSS-generated disbursement issued before November 25, 2009, and that disbursement remains unsigned in NPS, the payment must be cancelled and re-issued so that the offset may occur.
