

**AMENDMENT #1
AGREEMENT**

BETWEEN

**THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORATION**

AND

**THE STATE OF IDAHO
CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
THE IDAHO EASTERN SNAKE PLAIN AQUIFER
CONSERVATION RESERVE ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (CREP)**

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Amendment to the Agreement between the United States Department of Agriculture, the Commodity Credit Corporation, and the State of Idaho is to modify the original language of the above-captioned CREP agreement, as follows.

II. AMENDMENT

Section III. Authority. The enrollment date referenced in paragraph 1, last sentence is deleted.

Section IV. Program Elements, paragraphs D. and E. on page 3 have been changed to read:

D. CRP contracts executed under this Agreement will be administered in accordance with the CRP regulations at 7 CFR Part 1410, the provisions of this Agreement, and National CRP Directives. In the event of a conflict, the CRP regulations will be controlling.

E. No lands may be enrolled under this program until both the USDA's CREP Program Manager approves a detailed Idaho amendment to the National CRP directives, which will provide a thorough description of this program and its applicable practices, and the appropriate level of environmental analysis has been completed as required by the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 as amended, related Statutes, Executive Orders, Departmental Regulations, and in accordance with 7 CFR Part 799.

Section IV. Program Elements, paragraph G. i. (b.) has been changed to read:

For practice CP22 acreage, meet continuous sign-up eligibility criteria as determined according to FSA CRP National Directives.


Section IV. Program Elements, paragraph G. ii. (a.) "Iirigated..." has been corrected to "Irrigated..." and the dates on line 4 have changed from "...1996-2001" to "2002-2007".

Section V. Federal Commitments, paragraph J. has been changed to read:

Idaho and the USDA agree to share appropriate data in strict accordance with the procedures, restrictions and exemptions established under the Freedom of Information Act and federal privacy laws, including Section 1619 of the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (Public Law 110-246, section 1619), Section 2004 of the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (Public Law 107-171, section 2004), and other applicable laws, with the State to facilitate State monitoring efforts according to the provisions in the Memorandum of Understanding between the Idaho State FSA Office and the State of Idaho CREP Cooperators.


